Biodynamic Developments from Italy

Three introductory workshops in May 2007

Enzo Nastati, former head of Demeter in Italy, began formal work with seed regeneration in 1987. The association "L'Albero della Vita" was formed in Trieste in April 1991 to develop the new possibilities which evolved from early successes. In the subsequent years of study, research and experimentation, over 100 preparations have been developed for agriculture - including products for purification of plants and soils, repellents of parasites and weeds, preparations and seed baths that stimulate particular impulses in the plants, and products that help plants suffering from meteorological stress. The association has also made developments in sensitive crystallization, water vitality, protection against electro-magnetic pollution, resistance to cross-pollination from GMOs, farm and garden design, architecture, and work with animals including bees. The discipline is called 'homeodynamic agriculture' to recognise that the use of potentised preparations has been built firmly upon the basis of Dr Rudolf Steiner's biodynamic agriculture.
