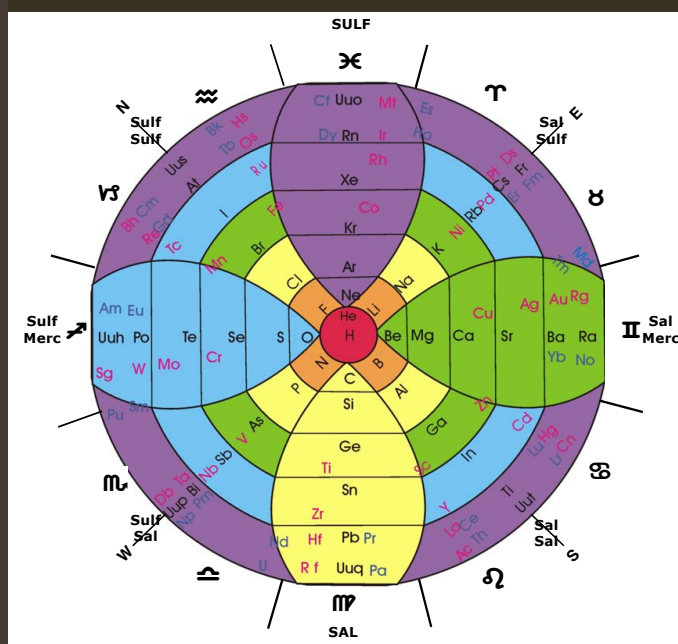
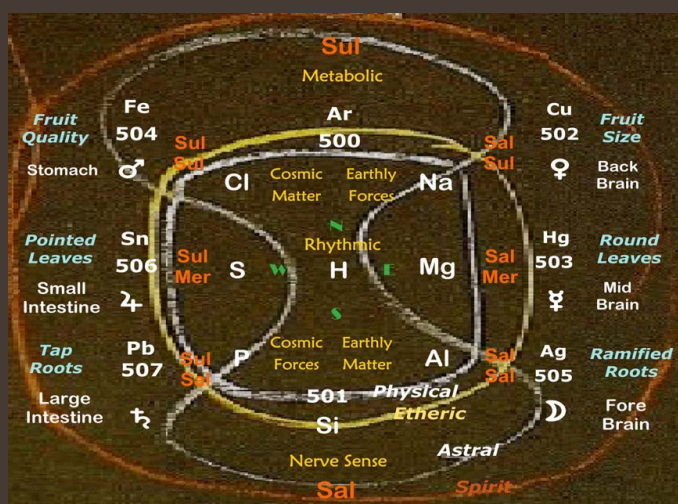


Chemistry and Life,
